

# What is being delivered at the new Oran Park High School

We are excited to welcome our new Year 7 and 8 students to Oran Park High School. The new school includes:

- 90 innovative learning spaces
- core facilities including fitness and performance studios, a hospitality café, makerspaces and a senior learning centre
- a hall to accommodate two basketball courts.

Delivery of this project is being coordinated with the upgrade to Oran Park Public School.

# Are there ongoing works during Term 1?

Works to be undertaken during Term 1 include internal fit out of block HD, associated landscaping works and installation of external sun shades. This area will not be accessible to students or staff until works are complete. It is expected these works will be complete by Term 2 2020.

### Will there be constructions work ongoing in 2020?

The majority of the classrooms have been completed. Stage 2 works will continue throughout Term 1 and will be complete by Term 2 2020.

# What safety measures will be in place?

The safety of the school's students, staff and the local community is our highest priority. Construction planning has been designed so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures such as hoarding, signage and separate access points are in place to ensure students are not able to enter the construction site.

To minimise disruption to school operations and activities, site deliveries will be scheduled outside of school drop off and pick up times and traffic control personnel will be on site to assist with contractor deliveries.

# What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Hoarding and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and our neighbours. Other dust mitigation strategies will be used as required.

# How will traffic be managed?

Traffic control and security measures are in place where required for the safety of the community.

# What are the school start, finish and break times?

- School start time: 8:50am
- School finish time: 3:00pm (Tuesdays: 2:35pm)

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Recess: 10:15-10:45am

### Lunch: 1:15-1:45pm

### How do I enrol my child?

Any new enrolments will be required to complete an enrolment form and provide the following information to the office:

- Birth certificate
- Two most recent school reports
- 100 point residency identification

Once this is received a risk assessment is sent to the previous school. When this is received an interview is booked with one of the deputy principals, either Ms Kristie Harris (Year 7) or Mr Chris Hollis (Year 8). A start date will be given during the interview.

### How do the classes run?

A school day consists of 4 x 75 minute periods which run on a two week cycle.

Term 1: Week B start

### Term 2, 3, 4: Week A start

Classes are of mixed ability and are named after gemstones:
