Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade the school facilities at Orana Heights Public School and remove demountables. Key upgrades will include:

- 8 new classrooms
- refurbishment of 14 classrooms and 4 special programs rooms
- school hall extension
- upgrading the library
- external upgrades including new signage and covered walkways

Progress summary

We are currently in the process of evaluating tender submissions. The main works construction contractor is expected to be selected in the coming weeks.

Next steps

- 5 demountables are expected to be relocated during the July school holidays to allow for site establishment. We will provide more details before this work starts.
- Once appointed, the contractor will finalise the design for construction purposes and the statutory planning application will be submitted for approval.
- Construction is expected to begin in late 2025.
