Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Orange Grove Public School is being upgraded to include additional fit-for-purpose learning spaces and new core facilities to provide sufficient spaces to learn and play, while meeting the growing enrolments needs.

Progress Summary

We have reviewed feedback collected during consultation with the school and broader community, and we have developed a revised masterplan proposal in consultation with the School and the P&C. Several aspects have been considered in the revised masterplan, including heritage, Education Facilities Standards Guidelines (EFSG), Inner West Council control plans, projected student numbers, tree protection and statutory planning options. We will be hosting a community information session to provide more details about the latest masterplan.
