Remediation works

Over the weekend, material containing suspected bonded asbestos was found in Orange Grove Public School's playground.

Testing will be conducted by an independent hygienist to confirm the nature of the material and if remediation is needed.

As a precaution, the area has been cordoned off to keep students, staff and school visitors separate.

If the material is confirmed to contain asbestos, remediation of the area of the will be undertaken by an independent hygienist, after school hours and the school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is reopened to students and staff.


All work will be done in accordance with work, health and safety laws, and the site-specific Asbestos Management Plan, completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.
