Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project to upgrade Parramatta East Public School is in planning and includes a new three storey building on Albert Street East featuring:

- 24 classrooms, 6 shared common areas, and 6 large multipurpose spaces.
- a new school library.
- a new learning support unit with 3 classrooms a shared common area and multipurpose space.
- secure administration with separate public and student entrances.
- student amenities.

In addition to the new building, upgrades to the existing school facilities include:

- refurbishment of 6 existing classrooms and conversion of the existing library to a staff room.
- additional staff parking.
- removal of demountable classrooms to provide more play space for students.
- landscaping around the school.

To make way for the new building, blocks C,D,E & F (facing Albert Street East) will be demolished.
