Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

As Parramatta East Public School celebrates 75 years of delivering public education in 2024, an exciting project to upgrade the school is in planning.

This proposal includes a new three storey building on Albert Street East and upgrades to the existing school facilities. It is anticipated the upgrade will include:



24 new classrooms



Secure administration with separate public and student entrances



A new learning support unit with three classrooms



A new school library



Additional staff parking



Removal of demountable classrooms to provide more play space for students



Refurbishment of existing classrooms and conversion of existing library to a staff room



Public domain works to improve pedestrian safety outside the school

To make way for the new building, blocks C,D,E & F (buildings currently facing Albert Street East) will be demolished.



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Progress update

 Concept designs have been developed for the school upgrade in consultation with the Parramatta East Public School leadership team. You can see some early artist impressions on both pages of this update. Note these are not final and are subject to change as the design and planning approvals progress.

Next steps

- In the next stages of design, more detailed designs of the insides of the buildings and the plan for the whole school will be developed and shared with the community.
- An information session will be held in Term 4 2024 to share these designs with the school community and answer any questions about the upgrade.
- Development approval and a tender process to appoint a contractor to complete the design and construction works will occur.
