Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Passfield Park School for Specific Purposes

A project is underway to redevelop Passfield Park School for Specific Purposes. The vision for the school is to create a new environment that strengthens communication and a greater sense of wellbeing by providing active and passive recreational facilities for all.

The project is being fast tracked to meet the requirements of the school and the community. The project will deliver:

- 16 new permanent teaching spaces
- A new library and a hall
- A new entrance and drop off area for parents/ carers and students

- New modern core facilities including staff and administration areas
- A new covered outdoor learning area
- A new hydrotherapy pool

Progress Summary

The consultant team has been appointed and the concept master plan has been developed. The schematic design is being developed with feedback from, and in consultation with, the school community. A tender package is also being prepared for the main construction tender.

Next steps

- Finalise schematic design.
- Request for tender (RFT) for main construction contractor.
- Award main construction contractor.
- Commence construction works late 2020 pending planning approval.



Will the school be relocated during the rebuild?
