Pendle Hill High School Works notification | 10 December 2022

School Infrastructure NSW is upgrading Pendle Hill High School to bring students new and improved facilities and support the growing student community.

Reminder: Binalong Road Works: starting Monday 12 December 2022

As previously notified, we are improving pedestrian access around Pendle Hill High School. Raised pedestrian crossings are being installed at each end of the school site on Binalong Road. The kerb and footpath between these two locations will be extended to help improve traffic calming and public safety.

The footpath on the western side of Binalong Road between each end of the school will be widened to improve accessibility for bus passengers and for school pickup and drop off. Stormwater upgrades will also be made along this length including installation of new pits and trench grates at each pedestrian crossing.

Changes to parking restrictions will also be made in the area. To enable easier school pick up and drop off, a kiss and drop area will be introduced on the western side of Binalong Road. When the road works have finished a No Parking zone (8 am to 9:30 am and 2:30 pm to 4 pm Monday to Friday) will apply for approximately 50 metres just south of the school. Further to this, the existing timed bus zone on the western side of Binalong Road along the front of the school will become a bus zone at all times. One of these spaces will be a loading zone for the school from 9:30 am to 2:30 pm, Monday to Friday. Please see location details provided on the map overleaf.

During the work period, Binalong Road will remain open to traffic. The works will be staged to allow flow of traffic to a single lane in both directions. Access to residential properties will be maintained during the works. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to ensure safe and efficient traffic management during this period.

Access arrangements for residents

One way access will remain open on Binalong Road between Ford Street and Burrabogee Road for residential driveways and pedestrians.

Hours of work

Approved standard construction hours are:

- Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm
- Saturday, 8am to 1pm.

Works not exceeding background noise level plus 5 decibels may take place during additional hours of:

- Monday to Friday, 6pm to 7pm
- Saturday, 1pm to 4pm.
