Pendle Hill High School upgrade

A project is underway to upgrade Pendle Hill High School to support the growing student and community needs.

The project proposes to deliver:

- a new three storey building with 14 new, modern flexible learning spaces
- a range of new core facilities and student amenities
- a new lecture theatre and library spaces
- a prototype learning area and staff development space.

Progress summary

A State Significant Development application for the new building will be lodged in May 2021.

Taylor has been appointed as the construction contractor for the Pendle Hill High School project.

Early works site preparation

Work has commenced to prepare the site for the planned refurbishment and construction works.

This includes the installation of temporary accommodation for the library and administration unit during construction.
