Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Penshurst Public School

An upgrade is underway to redevelop Penshurst Public School in response to projected growth in the local government area. The project will deliver 47 new flexible teaching spaces, new student, staff and administration facilities, a new library, hall and covered outdoor learning area, as well as maximised open play space.

Progress summary

Progress has continued on the Penshurst Public School redevelopment, with all ground floor concrete slabs installed and Level 1 concrete slabs poured. Trenching works are continuing to enable the installation of in-ground services throughout the site. A hoarding has been installed over the footpath on Arcadia Street to enable the tower crane to lift loads over the footpath from the street with no disruption to footpath access.

Next steps

During Term 1 2020, work to the structure is continuing including formwork, reinforcement installation and concreting to Levels 2 and 3.
