Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Penshurst Public School

An upgrade is underway to redevelop Penshurst Public School in response to projected growth in the local area. The project will deliver 47 new flexible learning spaces, new student, staff and administration facilities, a new library, hall and covered outdoor learning area, as well as a maximised open play space.

Progress summary

- The structure of the new building was finished in mid-April with the pouring of the Level 3 concrete slabs (known as “topping out”).
- A new stormwater connection to the street is complete.
- Electrical works to upgrade power supply to the school are complete. Energisation will occur in late 2020.

Next steps

Upcoming work activities for the remainder of Term 2, 2020 and the July school holidays include:

- installing external cladding, internal framing, stairs, windows and steel roof structure for the new buildings
- installing plumbing and electrical services
- connection of new sewer.
