Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Penshurst West Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Penshurst West Public School. The project will deliver seven innovative learning spaces in a new building, new student amenities, and a special programs room.

Progress Summary

Classes in Block A and C have been relocated into the demountable buildings. The design of the new building is being finalised.

Next Steps

The main contract is out to tender and the works will be completed under a CDC (Complying Development Certificate) approval process. Main works including the demolition of Block A and C are expected to commence in mid 2019.
