Works notification

We are upgrading Picnic Point High School to bring students the latest educational facilities and support the growing local community.

Early works

During the summer school holidays early works will continue to finish site establishment at the location of the new Technical Applied Science (TAS) building and removal of internal finishes within the ground floor of Block A (see map below), following this main works construction activities will start in early 2022.

The main works activities include bulk earthworks, levelling the ground and installing concrete footings for the new building, plus installing inground services for stormwater, sewerage and electricity.

This work maybe noisy at times; control measures will be implemented to reduce noise impacts on local residents in accordance with planning approval requirements.

This work will take place between the hours of 7 am and 6 pm Monday to Friday and 7:30 am to 3:30 pm Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.

No work will be undertaken from Saturday 25 December 2021 to Monday 3 January 2022 inclusive.
