

Picnic Point High School upgrade

Works notification

5 November 2021

We are upgrading Picnic Point High School to allow for greater access to secondary school co-educational facilities in the area.

Site establishment

The early works for the Picnic Point High School upgrade will start from Monday 8 November 2021.

The works include site establishment at the location of the new Technical Applied Science (TAS) building and the removal of the internal finishes within Block A. *See map overleaf.*

The safety of the school's students, staff, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. Construction planning will be designed so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures will be in place to separate the construction site from areas occupied by the school and ensure students are unable to enter construction areas.

Noise control measures will be implemented. Secure fencing and shade cloth will be installed to reduce noise impacts on the school and local residents.

Working hours

Our work hours are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, 9 am to 1 pm on Saturday. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.

COVID-19 safety plan

A comprehensive COVID-19 Safety Plan will be in place for the site and the contractor will enforce strict compliance with the Public Health Order. The construction site will follow all current health guidelines.

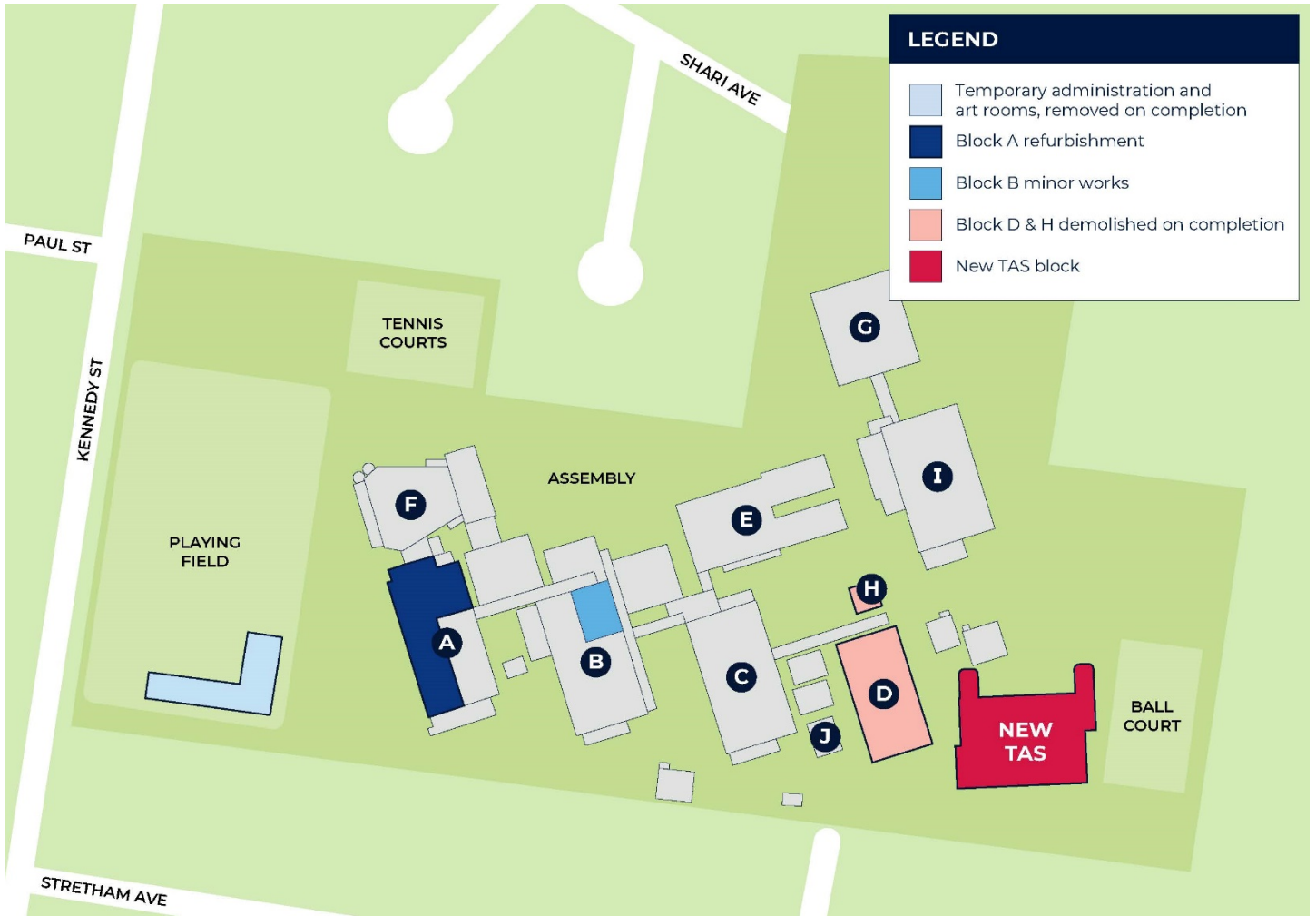
Safety is the number one priority for School Infrastructure NSW and we are following all health advice in relation to all construction sites we manage.
