## Project summary

We are excited to announce the new technical applied science building has been finished.

School Infrastructure NSW has handed over the following new facilities and external works to the school:

- a new technical applied science building Block L with technical, computer, music and arts workspaces
- new administration facilities within existing Block A
- upgraded learning spaces in Block A and B
- removal of the demountable administration facilities to create a new open play space
- removal of the art rooms near Kennedy Street
- demolition of the existing technical applied science building (Block D) and storeroom with kiln (Block H).

Landscaping works, including tree planting along the fence line of Streham Avenue are also complete.

Trees will soon be planted along the fence line of Thomas Street by the Department of Education’s Asset Management unit. This unit is responsible for all ongoing general maintenance of Picnic Point High School.
