Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years, along with a record \$500 million for the sustainable Cooler Classrooms program to provide air conditioning to schools. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across New South Wales. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Picton High School

A major project is underway to redevelop Picton High School. The redevelopment will provide new flexible learning spaces, a new library and administration area, performing arts spaces, special education facilities and a covered outdoor learning area and recreation areas. The existing hall will be refurbished. The new school will have capacity for 1500 students.

Term 1 school holiday works

Works will continue during the term 1 holidays including construction of formwork and structural steelwork for new buildings, predominately located in the centre and toward the Argyle Street end of the site.

During this time additional scaffolding will be installed near new and existing buildings, and earthworks and backfilling will continue across the site. The tower crane will be operational and used to move materials across the site.

You may hear noise created by usual construction activities including machinery such as grinders and handsaws, removal of tiles from existing buildings, concrete pours and movement of plant machinery. All efforts will be made to minimise noise as much as possible and works will only be carried out in the approved works hours for the main works between 7:00am to 6:00pm Monday to Friday and from 8:00am to 1:00pm Saturdays.
