

# Picton High School Redevelopment

## Works notification

29 April 2020

### Works recommencing on Wonga Road - Monday 4 May 2020

Planned works to install a roundabout at the end of Wonga Road are recommencing on Monday 4 May. Preparation works have commenced this week including the movement of temporary road barriers and the installation of machinery.

It is expected works will take approximately 6 - 8 weeks to be completed. The following arrangements are in place during the Wonga Road works:

- Alternative access to the drop off and pick up for Support Unit students will be located via the existing Argyle Street school entrance.
- School buses will continue to drop off and pick up students at the existing Argyle Street entrance.
- The existing teacher's car park near the Wonga Road entrance will be closed.
- The Wonga Road school entrance will still be accessible to pedestrians.
- Vehicle access to the end of Wonga Road will be limited during works. Provisions are in place to allow vehicle access to adjacent properties during the works.

Traffic and pedestrian management measures will be in place. Traffic controllers will ensure safe pedestrian access as the works continue. Pedestrians are advised to follow all directions provided by traffic controllers and signage when accessing the temporary school from Wonga Road.

Once works are complete, the new roundabout will provide bus and vehicle access to the temporary school while construction works take place on the Argyle Street bus area.
