Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Picton High School

A major project is underway to redevelop Picton High School. The redevelopment will provide new flexible learning spaces, a new administration area, performing arts space, special education facility and a covered outdoor learning area and recreation space. The new school will have capacity for 1500 students.

Progress summary

Works to upgrade Picton High School are progressing, with demolition now complete and bulk earth works nearing completion for this stage of the project. The next steps in the project are to install the tower crane on site and commence concrete and steel structural works.

Tower crane installation

In the coming weeks a tower crane will be established on the Picton High School construction site as part of the school upgrade. The tower crane will assist in construction works and with the movement of materials on site.

Appropriate controls and monitoring measures will be in place for the duration of the time the crane is on site. Crane loads are restricted to lifting within the perimeter of the construction site and no loads will be lifted over residential or public areas.

The safety of students, staff, neighbours and the community remains the highest priority at all times.

Wonga Road works

The previously postponed works to install a new roundabout in Wonga Road are still scheduled to occur during the redevelopment of the school. The works were previously put on hold due to unexpected in ground finds, and the project is working with other agencies to progress these works.

The school community, neighbours and local businesses will be regularly informed about the progress of these works, with more detailed information to be provided prior to commencement.
