Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Project timeline

A major project is underway to redevelop Picton High School. The redevelopment will provide new flexible learning spaces, a new administration area, performing arts space, special education facility and a covered outdoor learning area and recreation space. The new school will have capacity for 1500 students.


Progress summary

Works are progressing on the redeveloped school, with the demolition stage now complete. The project team is currently working with planning authorities to meet requirements. The tower crane will commence installation on site in the coming weeks with construction to commence shortly afterwards.

Concrete structural works are scheduled to commence in September 2019, with steel structural works to commence in November 2019.
