Picton High School Works notification



In line with the NSW Government's COVID-19 Guidelines, construction on the Picton High School redevelopment will resume from Saturday 31 July 2021.

A comprehensive COVID-19 Safety Plan is in place for the site and the contractor will enforce strict compliance including no workers from the LGAs of concern with the exception of authorised workers allowed under the Public Health Order. Our construction sites will follow all current health guidelines, including a one person per 4sqm rule and all workers wearing masks for indoor and outdoor work.

From today, Saturday 31 July 2021, you may see workers on site carrying out permitted preparatory works to enable work to resume safely.

In compliance with the latest Construction Work Days Order issued on 10 June 2021, construction is permitted to take place between 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday and 7 am to 5 pm Saturday. Limited works can take place on Sundays from 9 am to 5 pm. No work will take place on public holidays.
