Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Prestons Public School

An upgrade is underway at Prestons Public School to add new permanent teaching spaces for current students, as well as preparing the school for projected growth in the area. The project will deliver 10 new permanent teaching spaces, an extension to the administration building, alterations to the library facade, provision of outdoor learning spaces and an extension to the hall.

Progress summary

The upgrade to the administration building and alterations to the library facade have been completed and the new administration building is operational.

The construction of the new building with 10 learning spaces is near completion.

Summer school holiday works

Construction work will continue over the summer holiday with removal of the hoarding, some landscaping work and removal of the some of the demountable classrooms.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 5:00pm and Saturday, 8:00am to 1:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

A number of demountable classrooms will be removed during the summer holidays. Construction work will continue with removal of the hoarding and some landscaping works.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer break will be as per the standard hours:

- Monday to Friday, 7:00am to 5:00pm
- Saturday, 8:00am to 1:00pm

No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

The site will be closed from 25 December 2019 to 1 January 2020.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
