Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Prestons Public School

An upgrade is underway at Prestons Public School to add new permanent teaching spaces for current students, as well as preparing the school for projected growth in the area. The project will deliver 10 new permanent teaching spaces, an extension to the administration building, alterations to the library facade, provision of outdoor learning spaces and an extension to the hall.

Progress summary

The upgrade to the administration building and alterations to the library facade have been completed and the new administration building is now operational.

Next steps

Building works will continue in the main building with the waterproofing of wet areas and installation of cladding and guttering. Work will also continue on upgrading the substation.

Over Term 3 school holidays, works will commence on the extension to the school hall. The hall will be boarded by hoarding to secure the construction work area and to provide a safety zone. The extension to the hall is expected to take eight weeks, weather permitting.

Alternate spaces for the groups who use the hall have been negotiated by the school. The OOSH will temporarily relocate to the demountable Administration block for the duration of the Hall works.
