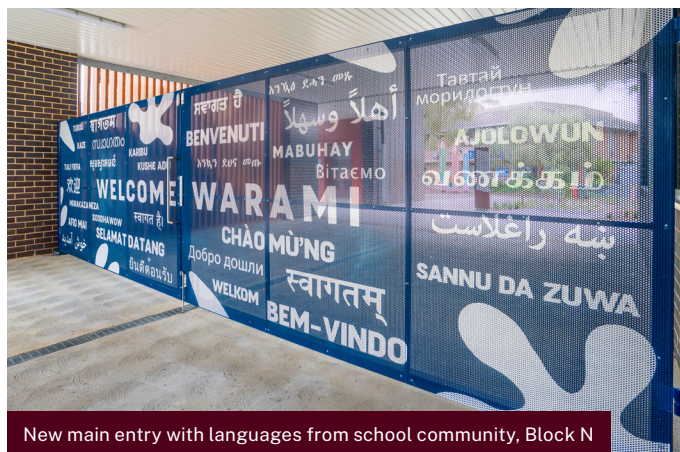

Frequently asked questions

What is being delivered as part of the Punchbowl Public School upgrade project?

The project includes a new two storey building facing Rossmore Avenue and refurbishment work to the existing administration building. The upgrade includes:

- 10 new classrooms (with works to add 2 support learning rooms into Block A underway)
- secure entrance on Rossmore Avenue with separate public and student administration entrances
- relocation of Support Unit to existing administration building (late 2025)
- refurbishment of early intervention spaces
- removal of 3 demountables.

When is the upgrade expected to be completed?

The work to upgrade the Punchbowl Public School will continue until late 2025.

What are the construction hours for this project?

The standard construction hours for this project are 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am to 4 pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sunday or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.

Future works

In addition to the works to refurbish Block A and convert the existing Administration area into a Support Learning Unit, further minor work to marry-in the new Block N to the existing school will be carried out.
