100 new public preschools

As part of the plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Government is investing \$769 million to deliver 100 new public preschools, co-located with public primary schools in NSW, to boost access to public preschool across the state. This is the largest investment in public preschools in NSW history, helping more children access a preschool program before starting school.

Progress summary

Work is underway to deliver a new public preschool at Cabramatta West Public School. The new public preschool will provide a safe and engaging environment for preschool children. The construction of the preschool is expected to be completed in time for Day 1 Term 1 2027.

We are preparing documentation to apply for planning approval for the project through a complying development certificate (CDC). Complying development is a combined planning and construction approval that can be determined through assessment by a council or an accredited certifier.

Site establishment works

Site establishment work for the new preschool will start from Wednesday, 20 August 2025, (see map overleaf for the site layout). These works will include:

- establishing a site exclusion zone with a temporary fence to isolate the work area from the school
- preparation for the internal demolition within existing Building M which will involve disconnecting services and putting in place temporary power, water, and sewage connections for site sheds, as required.

The demolition and strip-out works within Building M will start once services disconnections are complete. Heavy machinery such as excavators and bulldozers may be used, and works may be noisy at times.

Working hours

To minimise disruption to school operations, noisy demolition activities will be reduced as much as possible during school hours from 8:45 am to 3:15 pm.

- The contractor will finalise the design of the preschool.
- Once we have received the CDC, we will be able to advise the community of the construction and delivery timeline.
- Start site establishment, demolition and strip-out works.
