100 new public preschools

As part of the plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Government is investing \$769 million to deliver 100 new public preschools, co-located with public primary schools in NSW, to boost access to public preschool across the state. This is the largest investment in public preschools in NSW history, helping more children access a preschool program before starting school.

About the new preschool at Cartwright Public School

We are building a new preschool at Cartwright Public School. The preschool will be a safe and welcoming place where children can learn through play. The preschool will have places for up to 40 children each day and include:



2 preschool rooms



an outside play area



administration area and staff kitchen



amenities and storage

Progress update

Construction of the new preschool is nearly finished with final works being completed across the site. A sneak peek of the new preschool is shown on the following page.

Next steps

Over the coming months, we will complete the final stages of the preschool project, including obtaining service approval from the NSW Early Learning Commission, which enables us to operate.
