New public preschool at Gulyangarri Public School

Project update | June 2024

The NSW Government's 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

100 new public preschools

As part of the plan to rebuild essential services, the NSW Government is investing \$769 million to deliver 100 new public preschools, including building new public preschools at new government primary schools in NSW, to boost access to public preschool across the state.

New public preschool at Gulyangarri Public School

Gulyangarri Public School opened on Day 1 Term 1 2024. As part of the project, the new school includes an on-site preschool for up to 40 children. The preschool is situated in Building Y on the western side of the site and include two rooms.

The new public preschool at Gulyangarri Public School will be among the [100 public preschools](#) to be built across NSW by 2027.

Progress summary

A project is underway to complete the fit-out services for the new preschool at Gulyangarri Public School. We are delivering this project using a classification of works which do not require a Development Application, called a Complying Development Certificate (CDC). CDC plans and works are assessed by an accredited certifier rather than a local council.

We will soon submit the application for CDC and the approval process can take between 1 to 2 weeks. Once the approval is received, we will update you on the project progress, including the construction and delivery timeline.

The preschool is currently receiving expressions of interest from families who wish to enrol their child. Interested families need to submit the [expression of interest form](#) to the school office.

Upcoming works

Site establishment works for the preschool fit out will commence on 18 June 2024, weather permitting and may take a few days to complete. Ahead of site establishment works, the builder, ADCO, will undertake some initial tasks such as setting up their amenities area on level 2 of the admin block and installing fencing to segregate work areas from the school community. The site is shown on the map on the next page.

During site establishment works, the builder will:

- remove existing plasterboard from the preschool walls
- install acoustic barriers in the passageway, and
- erect temporary fencing around the work zone.

Construction vehicles and delivery access will be via internal road off Lachlan Street. Working hours are Monday to Friday, 7 am to 5 pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.

Where possible, the works will take place outside of school drop-off and pick-up times to minimise the disruption to the school community and surrounding neighbours. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently, and impacts on the community are minimised at every opportunity.
