Investing in our schools

As part of the plan to rebuild essential services, the NSW Government has invested \$769 million to deliver 100 new public preschools, including building a new preschool at every new NSW public primary school in NSW, to boost access to preschool across the state.

New public preschool at Gulyangarri Public School

The new public preschool at Gulyangarri is the first of 100 new public preschools set to open, as part of NSW Government's commitment to deliver expanded access to early childhood education.

Enrolments at the new public preschool at Gulyangarri Public School are now open. Families who wish to enrol their child in preschool should submit an <u>expression of interest form</u> to the school office. For more information visit the Gulyangarri Public School Preschool webpage.

Project overview

Gulyangarri Public School opened on Day 1 Term 1 2024. As part of the project, the new school includes an on-site preschool for up to 40 children a day. The preschool is situated in Building A on the western side of the school and includes two rooms. The project to complete the fit-out services for the preschool started in July 2024 and is now complete. The new preschool features specially designed rooms and a quality outdoor play area.

Next Steps

- NSW ECEC Regulatory Authority to assess the service approval application for the preschool service.
- Once service approval has been granted, the preschool will confirm the opening date.
