## 100 new public preschools

Work is underway to deliver a new public preschool at Ruse Public School. The new public preschool will provide a safe and engaging environment for preschool children. It will feature specially designed rooms and a quality outdoor play area.

## Upcoming geotechnical investigation works

From Monday 14 April, we will be conducting testing and environmental investigative works at your school.

The purpose of these investigations is to obtain information on the conditions underlying the site as well as to identify and mark any below ground services. These works will further inform the planning and design of the new public preschool.

Works will take approximately 2 days to complete and will be scheduled on 2 consecutive days in April, weather permitting.

These investigative works will include creating a small number of boreholes across the preschool site using a vehicle-mounted drilling rig and digging small test pits. All surfaces will be restored upon completion.

The area where investigations will be conducted will be cordoned off and inaccessible to staff and students during the works.

We anticipate minimal impact to the school operations as with the sound of the diesel motor will be roughly as loud as a commercial lawnmower.
