Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Progress summary

Some of the upgrade will be delivered by December 2019 including: administration refurbishment, staff facilities, food technology and hospitality facilities, landscaping, walkways and ramps around these three buildings, and the bus shelter.

Summer school holiday works

Construction activities will continue until 20 December 2019 with a two week shut down over the Christmas holidays. The work is scheduled to commence on 6 January 2020.

What works will remain in 2020?

Over Term 1 and 2 in 2020 works will continue on the following:

- Building A and Building F (refurbished general learning space and STEM spaces)
- COLA
- Refurbishing of sports courts
