This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

Project overview

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) is building a new hall at Queanbeyan West Public School. The hall will include:

- a new canteen
- Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) facilities
- storage and amenities.

Progress

The new hall project is progressing well with the building contractor, IQon, completing the following:

- earthworks
- pipes and cables laid
- main concrete slab poured to form foundation of new hall.
