Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

We're upgrading Randwick Boys High School and Randwick Girls High School to provide modern facilities and improve educational outcomes for the school community. The delivery of these projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students.

The upgrade to Randwick Boys High School will deliver upgraded science labs, a Fitness Learning Hub and new Technology and Applied Sciences (TAS) facilities.

The upgrade to Randwick Girls High School will deliver refurbished TAS facilities, a new woodwork learning workshop, enhanced library facilities and an administration reconfiguration that involves relocating the school entry.

In addition to the upgrades, other improvements will be made to both campuses including toilet facilities, roof replacements, power supply, enhancements to the halls and upgrades to movement areas, including covered walkways.

Progress summary

The contract for the construction of the new Fitness Learning Hub was awarded before the end of Term 4 2022 and construction started on 16 January 2023. Works to demolish the existing science laboratories are underway.

Over the summer school holidays, school-funded landscaping improvements were made around the school, and these are ready for the start of Term 1 2023.

Next steps

Works will continue on the new Fitness Learning Hub and construction is expected to be finished by the end of April 2023.

We have started the procurement process for the science laboratory upgrades and a contract is likely to be awarded this Term.

The procurement process for the electricity upgrade has also started and negotiations with electrical contractors and the energy authority are ongoing. Work on this upgrade is expected to start during this term and be completed in Term 2 2023.

Randwick Girls High School

Progress summary

Construction of the new woodwork learning facility is finished and it will be opened for teaching and learning in early Term 1 2023. Minor works to finish the fit out such as installing LED lighting will be completed over the coming weeks.

Over the summer school holidays, we completed planned maintenance works to upgrade staff bathrooms and replace the roof of Block C.

Next steps

Work on the roof replacement for Block E continues and is expected to be finished by mid-February 2023.

We have started the procurement process for the upgrades to the food technology classrooms and a contract is likely to be awarded this Term.
