Randwick Boys High School and Randwick Girls High School upgrades

Project update | June 2023

Project overview

We're upgrading Randwick Boys High School and Randwick Girls High School to provide modern facilities and improve educational outcomes for the school community. The delivery of these projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students.

The upgrade to Randwick Boys High School will deliver upgraded science labs, a Fitness Learning Hub and new Technology and Applied Sciences (TAS) facilities.

The upgrade to Randwick Girls High School will deliver refurbished TAS facilities, a new woodwork learning workshop, enhanced library facilities and an administration reconfiguration that involves relocating the school entry.

In addition to the upgrades, other improvements will be made to both campuses including toilet facilities, roof replacements, power supply, enhancements to the halls and upgrades to movement areas, including covered walkways.

Progress summary

Over the April school holidays, we finished refurbishing the kitchen and bathroom in the school hall (Building H), and these facilities are now being used.

We finished installing new exercise equipment in the Fitness Learning Hub (Building D), and this facility along with the new changerooms is now being used by students—see photos overleaf.

We are continuing work to upgrade the science facilities. We have finished works to convert the science general learning spaces in Building E, and these facilities are now being used for teaching and learning.

We also finished upgrading the roof of Buildings C and G as part of planned maintenance.

Next steps

Work will continue to upgrade the new science laboratories in Building F including installing new equipment and joinery, upgrading the flooring and painting. The laboratories are expected to be open for teaching and learning in Term 3 2023.

Work to finish the outdoor fitness area behind Building D will continue, including laying a running track. We expect work to be completed for the start of Term 3 2023.

A contractor for the electricity upgrade has been awarded and work will start later this Term.

Progress summary

Over the April holidays, we finished demolishing two existing food technology classrooms on the top floor of Building A.

Work to convert the two existing storerooms into a new staffroom in Building A is finished, and now being used by staff.

Resurfacing work on school quad is also now finished, and the quad has reopened.

Over the school holidays, we finished upgrading the roof of Building E as part of planned maintenance.

Next steps

Works to refurbish the food technology classrooms will continue, and these classrooms are expected to be open for use in Term 3 2023.

The library upgrade will be the next stage of work starting. The tender process is underway, and a contractor is expected to be awarded later this Term.
