## Notice of Determination of Application Hawkesbury Centre of Excellence (SSD-15001460)

I am writing to inform you that on 14 March 2022, the Acting Director Social and Infrastructure Assessments has granted consent to your development application Hawkesbury Centre of Excellence (SSD-15001460), as delegate of the Minister for Planning in accordance with Part 4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (the Act).

The development consent is subject to conditions, which are available on the Department's website. The reasons for the conditions are contained in the assessment report. The consent operates from 14 March 2022. The consent lapses on 14 March 2027 unless the development has physically commenced before that date (in the case of development consent for the erection of a building, subdivision of land or the carrying out of a work) or if the use of land, building or work is actually commenced before that date.

The Independent Planning Commission has not conducted a public hearing in respect of the application.

## Reviews/Appeals

Certain appeal and review rights are available to applicants and objectors following determination of a development application.

As the Applicant, you have a right to request a review of the determination under section 8.3 of the Act.

If you are dissatisfied with the determination of the application, as the Applicant, you have the right, under section 8.7 of the Act, to appeal to the Land and Environment Court within 12 months of the date the determination was notified or registered on the NSW planning portal.

The Department has an ongoing role in monitoring, and if necessary, enforcing the conditions attached to your approval.
