Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

This includes an upgrade to Rouse Hill High School to provide additional fit-for-purpose classrooms and amenities.

Project overview

The upgrade will deliver a 2-storey building which will include 9 modern classrooms, 2 science labs, 2 science classrooms and a flexible, collaborative learning area.

Progress summary

The planning pathway, a Review of Environmental Factors (REF) is now approved. Details on the approved activities can be viewed at edu.nsw.link/RouseHillHSREF.

Patterson Building Group has been appointed as the construction contractor and it's expected that work will start in late 2025.

Next steps

We have now progressed into the design finalisation phase prior to construction starting for the upgrade at Rouse Hill High School.

The next steps will include:

- Finalising the detailed design for the upgrade
- Site establishment and enabling works - including putting up fencing and setting up site offices for the construction contractors.
