Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW.

In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Rutherford Public School

A project is well underway to upgrade Rutherford Public School to meet the future school enrolment demand. The project will deliver new permanent facilities including flexible and innovative learning spaces for 21 classes, a new administration building, hall, canteen, special programs room, and amenities.

Following the completion of the main upgrade works a new school library will also be built in 2020 beneath the new homebase building to support the future school population. The existing library in the middle of the school will be removed which will increase the school's outdoor playground space and improve supervision of students.

Early handover of new facilities Week 4 Term 4, 2019

The new school hall (Block B), canteen and special education (Block C), and special programs learning space (Block F), Covered Outdoor Learning Area (COLA), and central courtyard area have been completed and will be ready for the school to use from 4 November, 2019.

New homebase building

The new homebase building (Block K) is on track for completion in early December, 2019.

Ongoing work areas will be fenced and hoarded off from the school with separate access established for construction workers.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently. We will continue to work with Rutherford Public School to ensure that disruptions are minimised.

Community information session

A community information session has been scheduled for **8am to 10am, Monday 18 November** to provide an opportunity to meet with the project team and learn more about the transition into the school's new facilities.
