# **Ryde Secondary College** Project update | May 2023

## Ryde Secondary College upgrade

A project is underway to provide Ryde Secondary College with new and upgraded learning spaces to accommodate increasing enrolments at the school. The project will deliver a new two-storey pavilion building with airconditioned learning spaces, a fitness lab, seminar spaces and staff facilities.

In addition to the pavilion building, planning is underway for more upgrades to improve the school's facilities and functionality.

The upgrade to Ryde Secondary College forms part of a broader strategy of investment in the Ryde area to cater for predicted enrolment growth. The investment also includes the Macquarie Park Education Campus and Midtown Macquarie Park new primary school.

## **Progress summary**

While wet weather has continued to cause delays for the project, the builder has recently finished putting in the stairs, lift well and covered walkways for the pavilion. Work has also started to install pipes and cables.

As the building is not yet ready for the school to use, we have worked with the school on temporary measures to ensure there are enough learning spaces to cater for enrolments.

## Next steps

The next steps for the project include continuing working on the pavilion's interior, extending the sports court and finishing the pathways that connect the pavilion to the rest of the school.

We will also continue to consult with the school leadership on the scope for additional upgrade works. We will provide further updates as the project progresses.
