



Ryde Secondary College

Project update | April 2024

Project overview

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to provide Ryde Secondary College with new and upgraded learning spaces to accommodate increasing enrolments at the school.

As part of the first stage of the project, a new two-storey pavilion building with airconditioned classrooms, indoor fitness training space, seminar spaces and staff facilities was completed in September 2023. More upgrades to improve the existing school's facilities and functionality are underway.

Progress update

Further to the project update dated February 2024, planning for the refurbishment of buildings B (Technological and Applied Studies), C (General Learning and Art), and D (General Learning and Science) is continuing. The construction tender process to appoint a building contractor for these refurbishments will start once the design is completed.

The design for the kitchen refurbishment in building B is complete, and the process to appoint a building contractor to deliver these facilities has commenced. Works are expected to begin during the July school holidays to reduce impacts to learning.
