Project update | February 2024

Project overview

A project is underway to provide Ryde Secondary College with new and upgraded learning spaces to accommodate increasing enrolments at the school.

As part of the first stage of the project, a new two-storey pavilion building with airconditioned classrooms, indoor fitness training space, seminar spaces and staff facilities was completed in September 2023.

More upgrades to improve the existing school's facilities and functionality are underway.

This project is part of the broader strategy to cater for predicted enrolment growth in the Ryde area. Other school infrastructure projects in the area include the Macquarie Park Education Campus and Midtown Macquarie Park new primary school.

Progress Summary

Stage 2 works at Ryde Secondary College include the refurbishment of Buildings A (Administration), B (Technological and Applied Studies), C (General Learning and Art), D (General Learning and Science), E (Science/ Staff), F (Library), G (Multi-Purpose Facilities), and I (Performance and Computer Learning).

The construction contract for Building A was awarded in late December 2023 and works were completed during the summer school holidays. Building A was reopened in time for Day 1 Term 1 with improvements including:

- replacement of walls, ceilings, and floor linings
- installation of mechanical ventilation and acoustic treatment to reduce outside noise
- refurbishment of the existing performance space to a music room
- replacement of blinds, carpets, and furniture
- new paint in multiple rooms
- installation of wireless access points as part of the network upgrade to the school
- Deputy Principal office converted into larger office with waiting area.

The delivery of some of the furniture and blinds was delayed and will be completed in the coming weeks. Remaining works to replace furniture and blinds will be carried out outside school hours.

Buildings B, C, and D are still in planning, with the design being finalised. The construction tender process will start once the design is completed.
