

Schofields Public School upgrade

Works notification | 23 May 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Schofields Public School with the construction of a new, purpose-built three-storey building.

Noisy works

As part of the construction activities, we will be undertaking work to remove vegetation and demolish a concrete path within the construction site, which will be noisy at times. See map below for location details.

Concrete demolition works will include saw cutting and jackhammering into a concrete slab and will be carried out on:

- Saturday 31 May from 8 am to 3 pm

Tree cutting and vegetation removal works will involve the use of chainsaws, stump grinding and a woodchipper, and will be carried out on:

- Monday 2 June from 7 am to 6 pm.

A site manager will be present throughout the works to address any urgent issues. Contact details will be displayed on hoarding surrounding the construction zone.

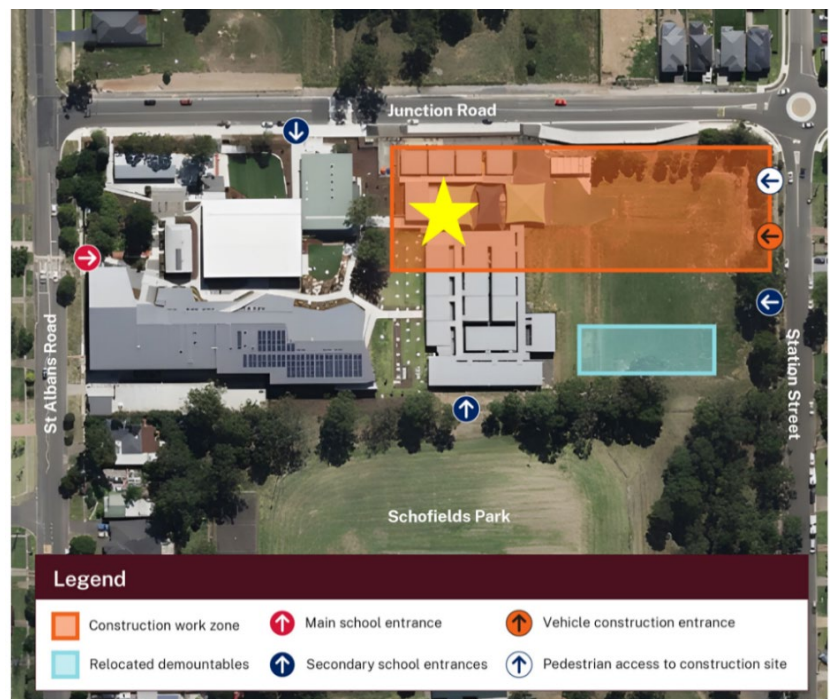
Site map
