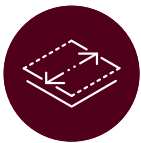

1,200 cubic meters of concrete used



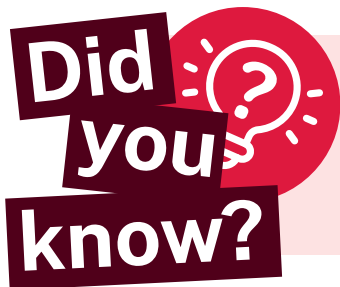
1,100 construction workers are involved with the project

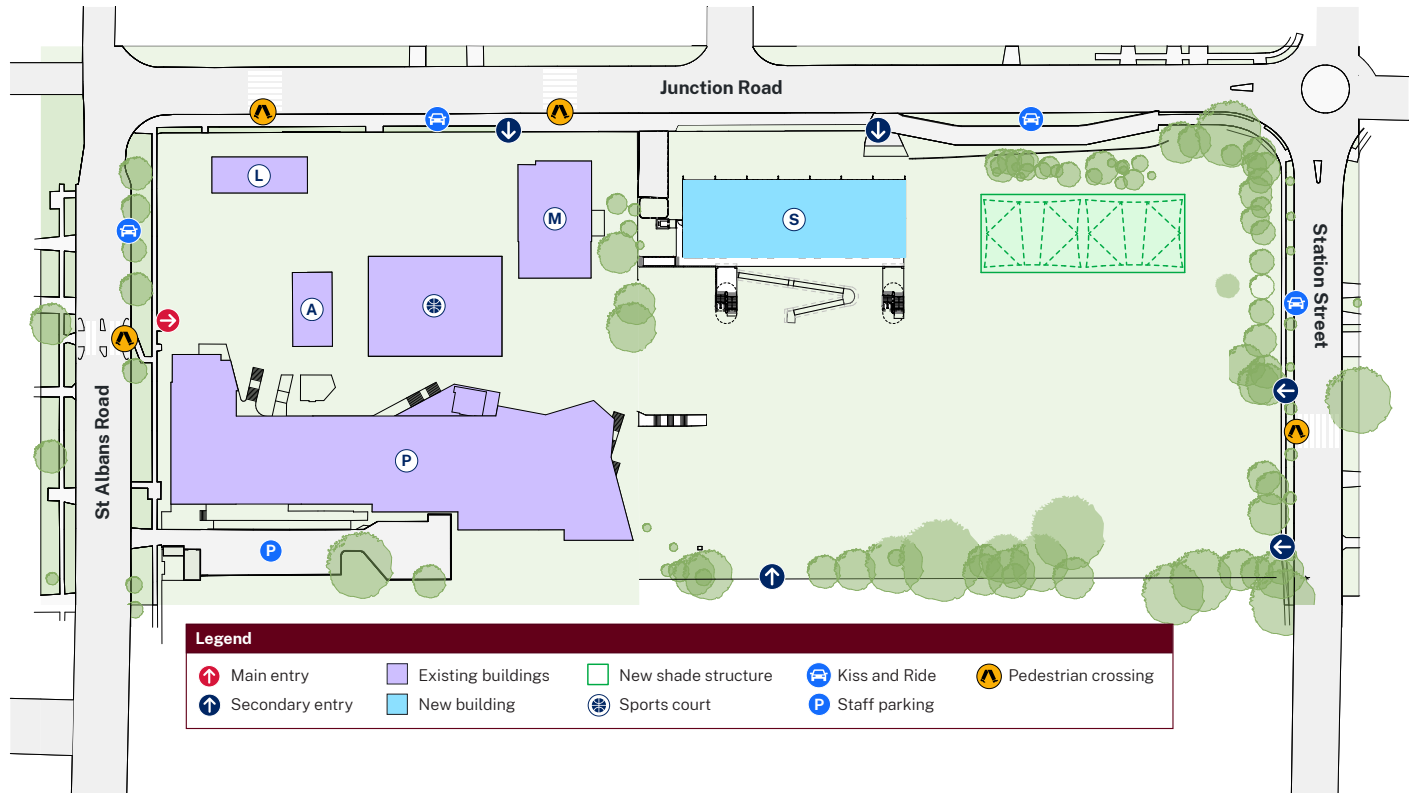
More than 60,000 hours worked



This upgraded school is designed to be eco-friendly! Solar panels have been installed on the roof of the new building to support energy efficiency, offsetting about 27.8 tonnes of carbon dioxide each year – that’s the equivalent of planting more than 2,300 trees!

This school campus map shows the locations of the new building and the newly installed shade structure within our school grounds. It also provides a visual representation of how the school will look after the removal of the demountable classrooms, showcasing the improved and refreshed campus layout.



Demountable removals

As part of the upgrade, 28 demountable buildings will be removed from the school site. A designated site area will be established to separate the works zone from the school, with the construction access gate located off Station Street. Traffic control will be in place as required to manage vehicles and pedestrians entering and exiting the area.
