Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Schofields Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Schofields Public School. The project will deliver 27 new flexible teaching spaces and upgraded core facilities to be built where the existing school facilities are located.

Progress summary

Day 1 Term 1 2019 marked the move to the temporary school at Schofields Public School.

Work has been continuing to progress the planned upgrade.

In late 2017 new planning laws meant the project was reclassified as a State Significant Development which changed the approvals process and timeline. The State Significant Development Application was lodged in early 2018 and the project was approved on 12 March 2019.

Next steps

Site preparation will start this month and is expected to be completed by the end of June.
