

Project notification

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Schofields Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Schofields Public School to accommodate 600 students. The project will deliver 27 new flexible teaching spaces and upgraded core facilities to be built where the existing school facilities are located.

During construction, staff and students will be accommodated in a pop-up school located on the top playing field and access to the bottom playing field will be retained.

Progress summary

Since early September temporary fencing has been erected around the top playing-field and foundations have been laid in preparation for the installation of the pop-up school.

October 2018

Installation of the pop-up school

Over the next few weeks, ProGroup Management, will install demountables for the pop-up school. These demountables will be brought to the site by truck and lifted into place by a crane. Once this has happened, covered walkways, ramps, power and water will be installed to complete the school.

We expect that the students will move to the pop-up school on day 1 term 1 2019 and use it for the duration of construction.
