Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Schofields Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Schofields Public School. The project will deliver 27 new flexible teaching spaces and upgraded core facilities to be built where the existing school facilities are located.

During construction, staff and students will be accommodated in a pop-up school located on the top playing field and access to the bottom playing field will be retained.

Progress summary

The construction contract has been awarded to ADCO Constructions Pty Ltd, and the temporary school has been installed.

The school holidays

During the holidays (20 December – 29 January), the school will be moved into the temporary school on the top playing field.

2019 school year

The school will operate from Day 1, Term 1, 2019 (30 January 2019) in the temporary school. Students, staff and visitors to the school should use the Junction Road entrance.

It is anticipated that planning approval for the new school will be given in February. Once this happens, temporary fencing will be erected around the existing school, ahead of the start of demolition and construction works.
