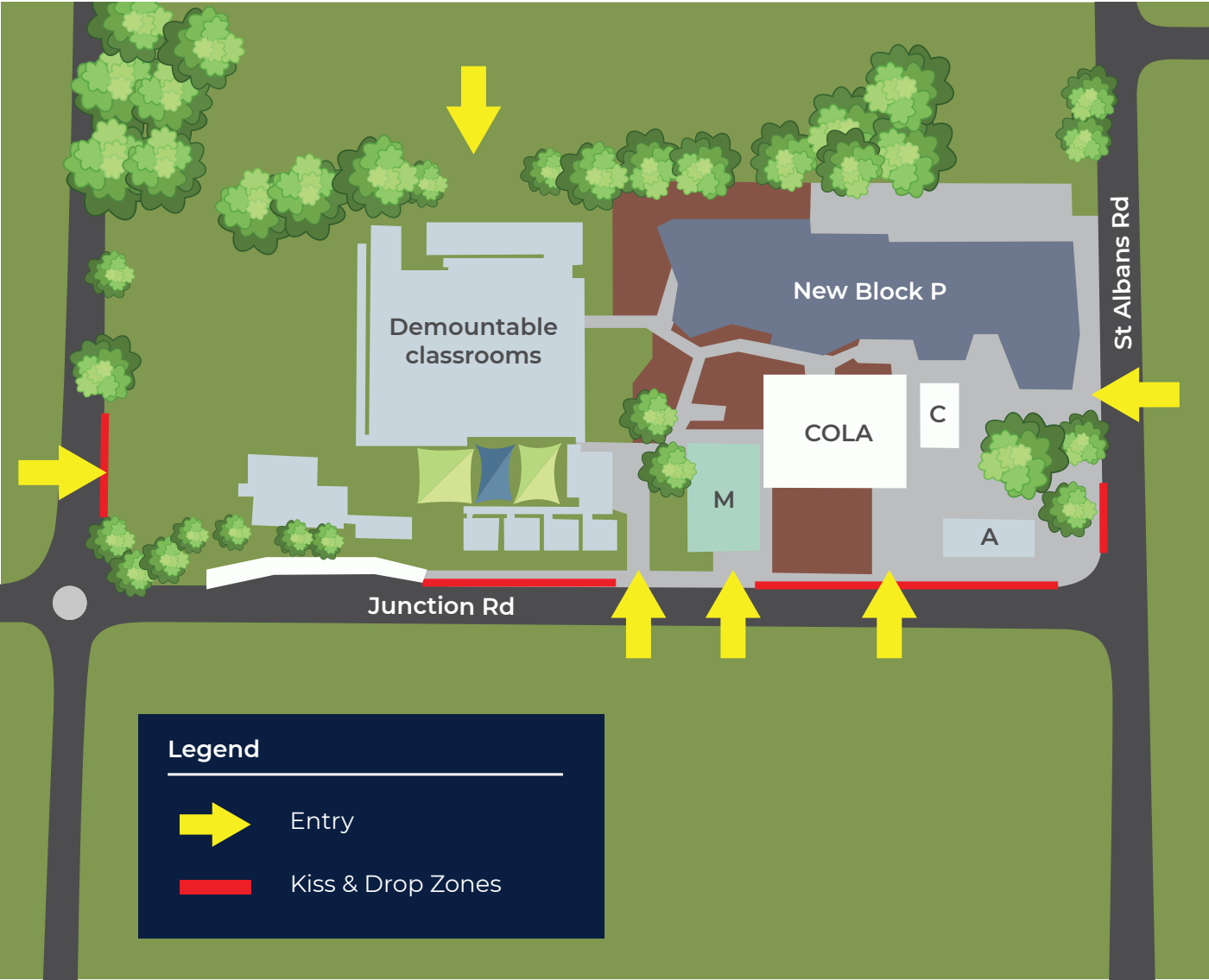
The project has effectively blended the rich history of the school with a very contemporary building, encouraging us to celebrate the past, work hard in the present and look to the future.

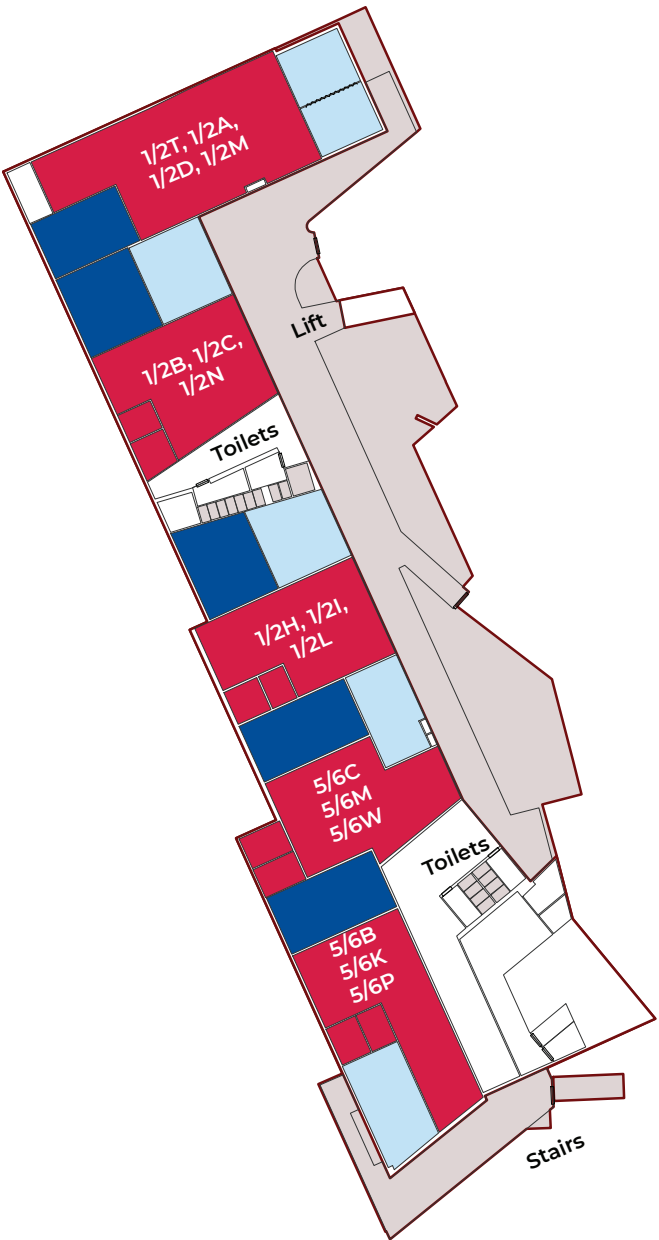
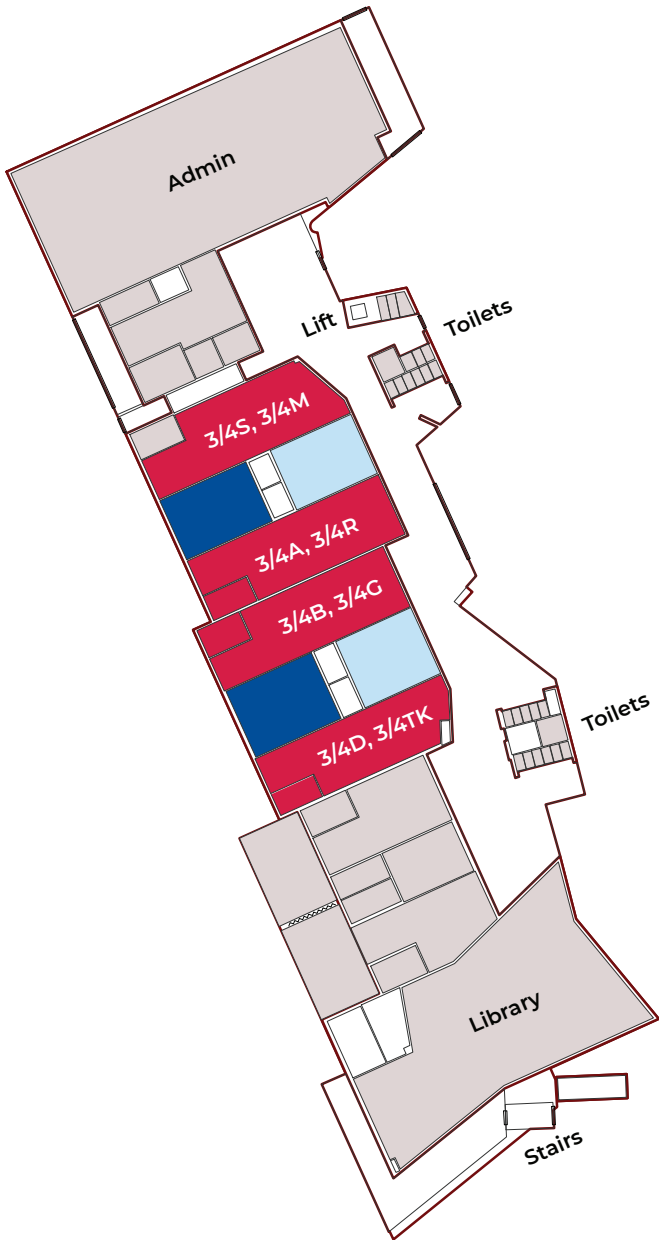
Map of Schofields Public School

Frequently asked questions

Can I accompany my child into school grounds on Day 1 Term 4 2020?

Due to current health advice, parents and carers are not permitted onsite. School staff will be onsite to welcome students and direct them to their allocated area under the COLA. Signage will also be in place. Class teachers will wait for students under the COLA before moving to their dedicated classrooms.

Which school gates will be open?

The school gates located on St Albans Road, Junction Road, Station Street and the Park Oval will be open on Day 1 Term 4 2020.

Where are the Kiss and Drop zones?

There are four active Kiss and Drop zones, two on Junction Road, one on Station Street and one on St Albans Road.

Will the school start and finish times change?

The start time remains the same with play in the playground from 8:45 am and classes commencing at 9:15 am.

The finish times will continue to be staggered to accommodate social distancing requirements:

- 2:45 pm – Kindergarten
- 2:55 pm – Years 1 and 2
- 3:10 pm – Years 3 to 6

When will parents be able to view the new facilities?

We are aware that parents and carers would like a tour of the new facilities.

While we are unable to run physical tours of the site due to the health restrictions in place, we look forward to welcoming our school community to view our new school as soon as we can.
