Seven Hills High School: VET upgrade

Project update | June 2023

Project overview

Seven Hills High School is being upgraded to provide a new Vocational Innovation Centre. These specialist vocational education and training (VET) facilities will provide students with the skills, support and access to trades and vocational pathways that will enable them to succeed in the 21st century.

The new Vocational Innovation Centre will primarily focus on the following industry areas:

- Human Services
- Construction (Electrotechnology and Plumbing)
- Supply Chain (Logistics)
- Business and Financial Services.

Progress summary

Construction work on the new Vocational Innovation Centre (VIC) is almost finished, with final fixtures, fittings and equipment being put in. The building is expected to be finished in June 2023. The school will then move in over the July 2023 school holidays, ready for learning to start in the new building from Day 1 Term 3 2023.

Students and staff will be able to access the VIC from the Johnson Avenue gates.

Next steps

Work will continue to finalise landscaping and the external walkway to connect the VIC to the rest of the high school. These work areas will be cordoned off to ensure the safety of all students and staff. This work is expected to be finished in early term 3.

Drainage works will continue to take place on Johnson Avenue, which are expected to be finished later in 2023.
