

Seven Hills High School: VET facility Project update | October 2023

Project overview

Seven Hills High School is being upgraded to provide a new Vocational Innovation Centre (VIC). These specialist vocational education and training (VET) facilities will provide students with the skills, support and access to trades and vocational pathways that will enable them to succeed in the 21st century.

TAFE NSW will deliver Individual support (ageing), Electrotechnology and Drainage (pre-plumbing course) as Vocational and Educational (VET) courses on campus in the VIC. Supply chain operations will be taught from 2024.

Seven Hills High School will deliver Business services, Financial services and Entertainment (live production and technical services) as Vocational and Education and Training (VET) courses on campus in the VIC. Sports Coaching will be taught from 2024.

Progress summary

The VIC is finished, and we are excited to let the school community know that the new building will be opening from Week 3 Term 4 2023, Monday 23 October 2023.

Students will continue to attend their TAFE courses at nearby facilities via bus transport for weeks 1 and 2 of term 4 2023, as has been the arrangements for terms 1, 2 and 3.

From Week 3 Term 4 2023, Monday 23 October 2023, all vocational courses run by TAFE NSW and Seven Hills High School will operate from the VIC.

The construction of the external walkway to connect the VIC to the rest of the high school and all landscaping work is now finished.

Next steps

Drainage works within the Johnson Avenue road reserve are expected to take place later in the year. A works notification will be published for the school and local community with more information about these works in due course.

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
