Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Project overview

Planning is continuing for an upgrade of Seven Hills High School to provide new specialist vocational education and training (VET) facilities as part of the NSW Government Vocational Schools Initiative.

The proposed vocational facilities will primarily focus on three industry areas:

- Community and health services
- Construction (Electrotechnology and Plumbing)
- Transport, Logistics & Warehousing

Progress summary

Our architects and planners have finalised a concept design for the provision of the new vocational education and training facilities.

The concept design was developed in consultation with the school and Department of Education

leadership representatives. The facilities required to deliver industry standard courses have been identified and included in the concept design.

Next steps

- The schematic and detailed design for the new vocational education and training facilities will be developed. This includes selection of fixtures, fittings and furniture.
- A Development Application (DA) for the school upgrade will be lodged with Blacktown City Council in mid-2021.
- Tender process for the appointment of a builder.
