

Seven Hills High School VET Upgrade

Works notification

1 October 2022

During construction of the new Seven Hills High School Vocational Education and Training (VET) facility, suspected asbestos containing material was found in the soil of the new construction area and in an existing electrical cupboard on the northwest corner of the site near the construction area.

The areas have been cordoned off and soils covered in Geotech fabric. Testing will be conducted by an independent hygienist to confirm the nature of the material and if remediation is needed.

If necessary, the areas will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations, the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan, and site-specific management plans. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited hazardous material removal contractors and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies, and guidelines.

The areas will be inspected to ensure they have been fully remediated and the contractor will receive a clearance certificate before the areas are re-opened.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
