Rebuilding Public Education

Sir Joseph Banks High School upgrade

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

The upgrade to Sir Joseph Banks High School includes brand new modern facilities in 2 new buildings and refurbishment across the existing school. Security upgrades and connecting walkways to link the new buildings will ensure accessible and safe access across the school.

The designs for the new and upgraded buildings and landscaping will incorporate connecting with country and traditional themes.

The upgrade will include:



16 new classrooms in hubs with shared common and multipurpose areas



Refurbishment works to Blocks B, C, E & F







A new welcoming building

The new 3 storey building facing Turvey Street will be a welcoming new face for the school with a secure entrance and separate reception areas for students and the general public.

It will feature modern new facilities and furniture for shared learning opportunities for students.

A lift and stairs will connect all 3 levels, with ramps and walkways connecting the new building with the existing school.

First and second floor

The layouts of the first and second floor are similar with the stairs ending at the second floor. Both floors contain:

- 8 classrooms

A new hall for the school community

- a COLA with overflow area for the hall









Building B Refurbishment

Refurbishment works to Building B (the current school hall) will include:

- painting to all walls and doors
- sanding and recoating of timber floors
- new pinboards in select areas
- reflooring of store rooms

This work will likely take place either after the new building is complete or during school holidays to minimise the disruption to staff and students. A timeline will be finalised once a contractor is appointed.

Building E Refurbishment

Minor refurbishment works to Building E (the current school tiered learning centre/library) will include:

- painting to all walls and doors on ground and mezzanine levels
- replacement of flooring in the science lab

This work will take place from late Term 4 2024 and continue into the summer school holidays.



Refurbishment works to the visual arts spaces will include:


- painting to all walls and doors





Timeline to completion

The next step to getting started on the upgrade is to get planning approvals and appoint a contractor to complete the works.

As we are undertaking upgrade work across the whole school site, it is expected that the work will need to be undertaken in stages to ensure the school can keep running as usual.

Construction work will take place year-round once started, with the most impactful works taking place during school holidays to minimise the disruption to the school community as much as possible.

The final timeline and order for the completion of the upgrades at Sir Joseph Banks High School is subject to approvals, the appointment of a contractor, and weather.

We are planning for all works to be completed by Day 1, Term 1 2027.

After a contractor is appointed, we will be able to finalise the stages and advise dates for the upgrade works to be completed. The timeline below gives an example of the order in which the works could take place.
