Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project to upgrade the Sir Joseph Banks High School is progressing. The upgrade is being managed by School Infrastructure and includes the construction of 2 brand-new, state-of-the-art buildings, along with extensive refurbishments and landscaping enhancements across the existing school campus.

- 16 new classrooms with 4 shared learning commons
- new administration hub
- new staff spaces including staff study and staff facilities
- new fit-for-purpose support learning hub
- new school hall and canteen with multipurpose sport court
- realignment and extension of school car park
- secure new entrance on Turvey Street with separate public and student entrances to new administration hub
- new covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and connecting walkways between buildings
- refurbishment works to existing classrooms and school facilities
- increase in support unit classrooms from 5 to 7 with purpose built facilities
- removal of demountable classrooms

Progress summary

We are planning to establish the construction site during the upcoming school holidays. This will include, installing construction hoarding and survey the site in preparation for the upgrade to begin in August 2025. See map on the next page showing the site location.

Work is underway to replace stormwater and sewer pipes at the rear of the school. A concrete path will be constructed once the pipes have been installed.

The upgrade to the library is now complete with new carpet installed earlier this term.
